- That students can earn 1 or more credentials in 31 of the 65 courses we offer?

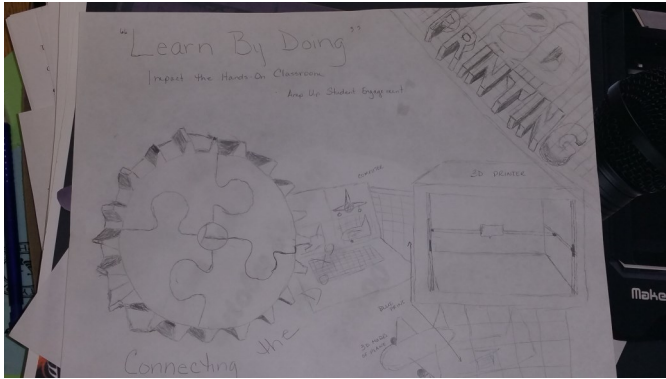

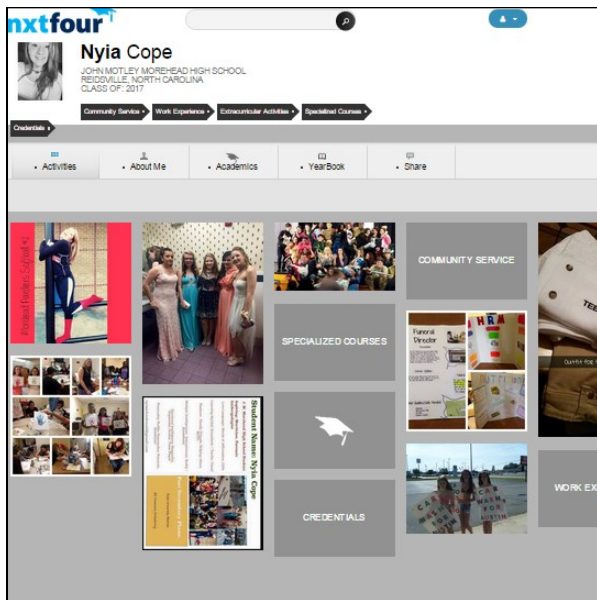

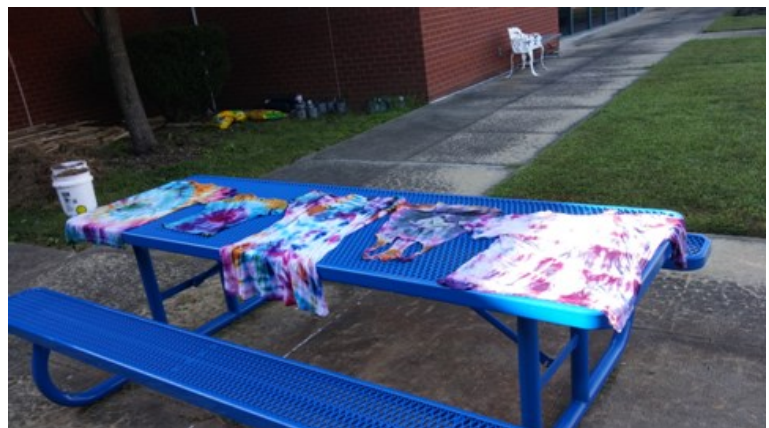
